

Nominate a tree for the Significant Tree Register

Help us grow a register of significant trees in Cardinia Shire by nominating a tree for Council's new Significant Tree Register.

Make your nomination via our online form and Council will review your suggestion to see if it fits the criteria.

Nominated trees will be assessed for their significance and those that meet the criteria will be added to the register. Trees that are added to the register have the potential to be adequately and appropriately protected through the Cardinia Planning Scheme.

Anyone can nominate a tree – Council officers, Councillors and community members.

What makes a tree significant?

A tree can be nominated for any of the following:

- its horticultural value
- being rare or localised
- being an outstanding example of species
- its location
- its age
- its outstanding size
- having a curious growth form
- having aesthetic value
- its historical value
- its habitat value
- Aboriginal significance
- having social, cultural or spiritual value.
